The Police Department has been addressing parking congestion and access issues in the Wilkinson Park area during ball games.

Chief Googins is recommending the *Traffic Schedule* be amended to prohibit parking on the north side of New York Avenue from Boston Street to the dead end and the entire length of the east side of Concord Street from May 1 to September 1.

Reference: Revisions to the Traffic Schedule

For some time now we have been dealing with significant parking congestion and access issues created by vehicles being parking on both sides of New York Avenue and Concord Street during ball games at Wilkinson Park on New York Avenue. Officers have spoken with many of the homeowners on the affected streets and are for the most part in agreement that something needs to be done to address this issue and that these changes are reasonable.

I would like to recommend the following changes to the traffic schedule:

- 1) The posting of the North (odd) side of New York Avenue from Boston Street to the dead end as No Parking from May 1 to September 1.
- 2) The posting of the entire length of the east side of Concord Street as No Parking from May 1 to September 1.

Please schedule these changes for Council action at your earliest convenience.

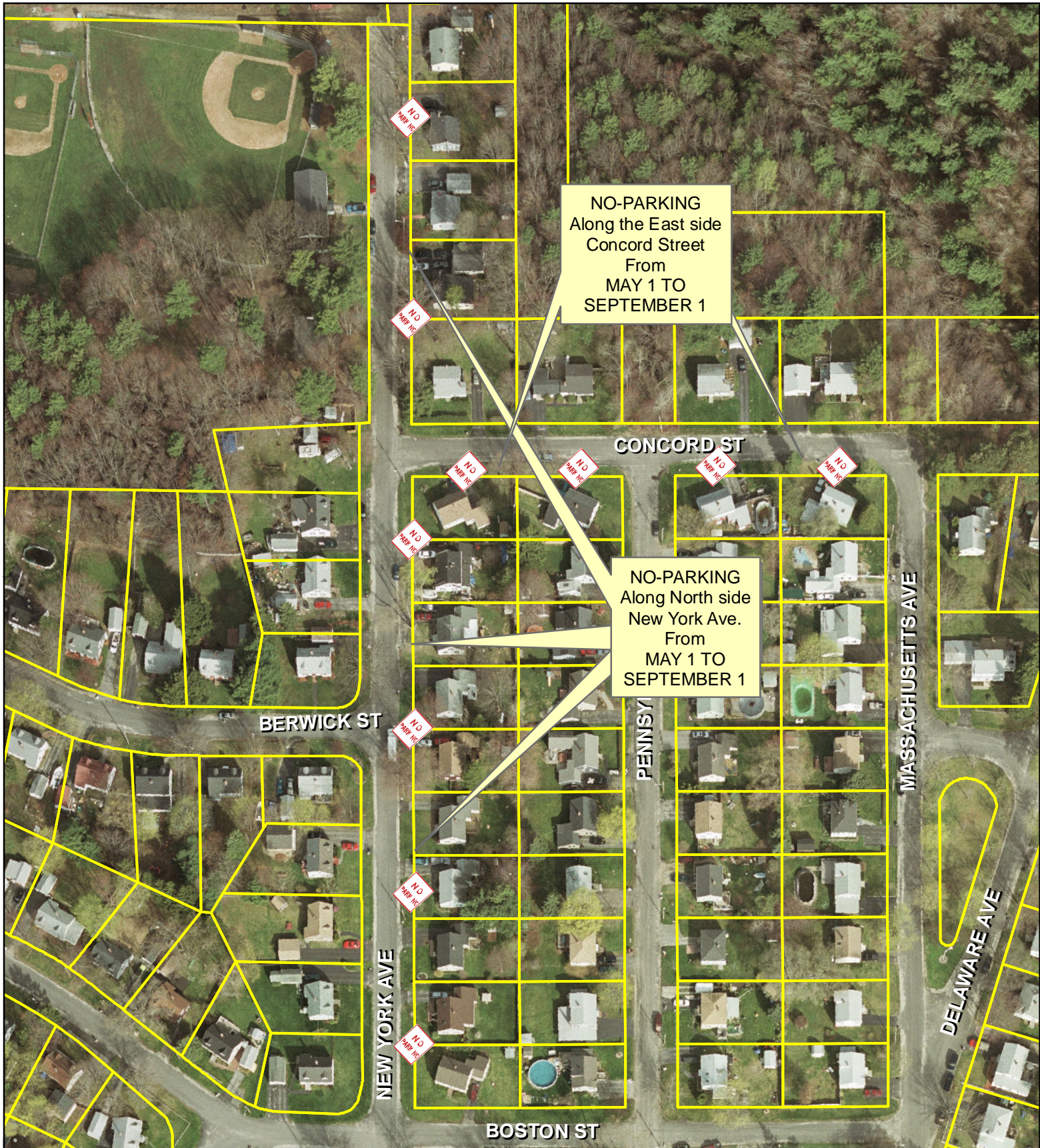

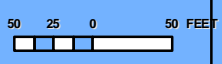
