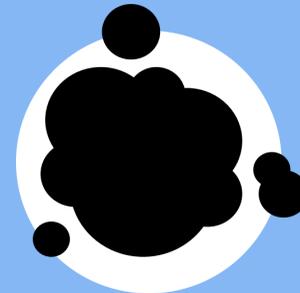


Responsible use of cannabis means being mindful of others.



The brain continues to develop until about age 25. Early use of any substance can impact that development. Help young people reach their full potential by waiting as long as possible before trying cannabis.



Be mindful of roommates and loved ones. Anything smoked or vaped creates second-hand smoke. If you smoke cannabis, do so outside to prevent unwanted exposure.



Storing your stash in a locking jar or box prevents young people from accessing your cannabis and children from accidental ingestion. Edibles can be mistaken for treats.



It is illegal:

- To provide cannabis to someone under 21.
- To drive while high.
- To use in public spaces.
- For non-U.S. citizens to possess cannabis under federal law.

Remember, like tobacco and alcohol the legal age is 21.
