**Robbery Update**

***SOUTH PORTLAND, Maine*** – On Friday, July 26<sup>th</sup>, at approximately 7:28 PM, the South Portland Police Department responded to the Liberty Commons apartment complex for a robbery complaint. A female victim reported being forcibly removed from her vehicle by two unknown males, who then stole her vehicle. A weapon was threatened, but one was never displayed.

The victim's vehicle was located in Casco the following morning, and brought back to the South Portland Police station for evidentiary processing. The investigation led through the weekend and all day Monday, when two suspects were identified. At approximately 6 PM on Monday July 29<sup>th</sup>, arrest warrants were issued for the two suspects charging Robbery (class A), Criminal Threatening (class D), Assault (class D), and Terrorizing (class D).

Suspect #1 has been identified as Davyn FLYNN, 18 years old from Portland. Recent Cumberland County Jail booking photos of Flynn are attached. Suspect #2 is a 16 year old male, whose name will not be released at this time.

If you have contact with the two suspects, do not approach them; call your local police department or 9-1-1.
