

# Types of Licenses

The City of South Portland issues local licenses for the following:

- Adult (18-plus) establishments
- Amplification device
- Amusement Centers/Devices, not otherwise defined
- Automobile Graveyards/Junkyards
- Automobile Service Centers (Gas Stations)
- Automobile Used Car lots
- Bottle/Social Clubs (BYOB establishments)
- Car Wash (for profit)
- Coin-Operated Game Machines
- Farmer's Market vendors

- Flea Markets and vendors
- Going-Out-of-Business Sales
- Establishments selling food including food prep on-site, no food prep-on-site (pre-packaged), restaurants, mobile vending units (food trucks), ice cream trucks, pushcarts, and catering
- Establishments selling alcoholic beverages for consumption on-premise and off-premise including taverns, retail stores, restaurants, catering, lounges, hotels, and non-profit clubs
- Games of Chance (Bingo, Beano, Raffles of prizes over \$10,000)
- Hazardous and Flammable Liquids (propane, gasoline, oil, diesel, etc)
- Junked Motor Vehicles
- Lodging Establishments (hotels, motels, bed & breakfasts, etc)
- Marijuana Establishments (Medical & Adult Use)
- Massage Establishments
- Massage Therapists (if not members of AMTA or ABMP)
- Pawnbrokers
- Secondhand Dealers
- Shelters
- Shooting galleries
- Short-Term Rentals ("Airbnb", rentals of less than 30 days)
- Special Amusement for Dancing and Entertainment (required for establishments that sell alcohol only)
- Taxi (must be based in South Portland)
- Theaters
- Towing/Wreckers
- Trucking, refuse removal (garbage/recycling/compost trucks)
- Transfer stations for Municipal Solid Waste
- Temporary vendors - fixed and door-to-door sales, including Christmas trees
- Use of public sidewalks (for outdoor seating, etc)
