

**CDAC Meeting Minutes**

The Committee discussed Public Service applications. They had questions about ridership levels on the South Portland Bus Service, Skillin Backpack program funding, and the Food Cupboard's leasing costs.

The Committee discussed the possibility of not holding "Open Mic Night" since there were no new Public Service applicants this year. They ultimately decided that they would hold the meeting so that they could have the opportunity to ask the applicants questions directly, and maintain the process for the future. The Committee asked staff to request that applicants not bring additional handouts to the meeting.

The Committee summarized the infrastructure/facilities applications. The City Manager also discussed the possibility of funding engineering costs for an addition to the Redbank Community Center. The Committee supported the idea. Members of the Committee also supported focusing on installing sidewalks and connectivity in the Redbank neighborhood, especially if the Redbank Hub is relocated to the new Community Center addition in the future.

Staff reviewed expected funding levels as well as unexpended funds from the previous year. The Committee supported the staff recommendations of allocating unexpended funds for Mill Creek Park, Westbrook Street sidewalks, a Knightville parking study, and emergency housing rehab.

The meeting adjourned at approximately 8:00pm.
