WHEREAS, by Proclamation dated and issued January 21, 2022, the Mayor of the City of South Portland declared a state of civil emergency within the entire City of South Portland; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 8-2.7 of the South Portland Code of Ordinances, a state of emergency declared by the Mayor shall expire if not renewed by the City Council within five (5) days;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED, that the state of civil emergency within the entire of City of South Portland be, and hereby is, extended and renewed until such time as the Mayor, or her successor as outlined in Section 8-2.6 of the Code of Ordinances, is satisfied that the civil emergency no long exists and a proclamation terminating the emergency is issued by the Mayor or said successor; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that, starting with the February 22, 2022 City Council workshop, the City Manager shall provide the City Council with a monthly report at the second workshop of each month, and continuing until the state of civil emergency is terminated, summarizing the community transmission level of COVID-19 for Cumberland County and the available methods of measuring the same so that the City Council may assess both the community transmission level and the available methods of measuring the same on a monthly basis for situational awareness and to continuously inform the Mayor of the necessity of the state of civil emergency in the City.
