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RATE CHANGES

The rates for disposal at the Transfer Station have not changed since July, 2003. Effective November 1, 2019 the rates will be changing as indicated on the reverse. The new rates will also be posted on the City’s website, on the city’s social media pages (<https://www.facebook.com/SouthPortlandPublicWorks>) and available in signage and handouts at the Transfer Station.

RESIDENT PERMIT STICKERS

Starting January 1, 2020 residents will be required to display a Transfer Station permit sticker to enter and use the Transfer Station as well as the Swap Shop. Stickers will be available at the Municipal Services Facility and at City Hall during regular working hours. The stickers are nontransferable and must be affixed to your vehicle. Stickers will be free to residents. If residents feel they need an additional sticker for a second vehicle there will be a \$5.00 charge for the second sticker. No more than two stickers will be issued per household. Stickers will have to be renewed January of each year.

To obtain a Transfer Station sticker you must show proof of residency, consisting of your vehicle registration and one other form such as driver’s license or utility bill.

CONTRACTOR CHANGES

Starting on January 1, 2020 contractors will have to pay an annual fee of \$150 to use the transfer facility. Permits will be available at the Municipal Services Facility and at City Hall during regular working hours, and will be issued once the contractor pays the fee.

Contractors may only bring in leaves, grass, or brush and must pay the associated fees for disposal each time they use the facility. (No running tabs will be maintained.)

Contractors must show proof that the material they are disposing of is from a South Portland resident by providing the resident’s permit number. Contractor’s permits will have to be renewed January of every year.
