

ELECTION WORKERS INFORMATION FORM

Are you interested in working on election day? If you are interested in having your name submitted for consideration, please fill out an application and return it to the City Clerk's Office at your convenience. These are paid positions (\$11/hr) and paid training is mandatory to attend before each election.

Qualifications:

Election Worker

- U.S. Citizen
- At least 18 years of age (except that student election clerks may be 17 years of age and may perform all the functions of an election clerk)
- Registered voter

Responsibilities:

Election Worker

- Supervise Incoming Voting List – check voters off the list and give out appropriate ballots;
- Oversee Ballot Box – ensure all ballots are deposited in the ballot box by the voter
- Count Ballots – tally ballots and fill out reports at the close of the election
- Assist Warden – help monitor petitioners and campaign activities
- Attend Training – must attend training before each election (approximately two hours)
- Attend Polls – attend voting place for scheduled hours
- Perform other Duties – perform any other election duties at the warden's request
