It was identified that it would be most feasible to divide the work so that no one person was responsible for many calls. At the meeting, suggestions were made for questions for Sue to ask the Health Officers during the next "did you know" session and ideas presented for other Did you Know programs.
- Housing: Review draft shoveling plan was presented. Sue will meet with the city attorney, Chad has contacted the City Manager about the Social Service person helping, the group agreed to the plan and recruiting volunteers will occur when details finalized. The SP/CE rotary may help. Publicity can occur through Sentry articles, face book, the city web site and newsletter, SPTV and flyers can be posted in the library and Community Center as these sites are open. Chad will publicize the sand bucket program (Public Works OK with plan) . It was suggested that recycling barrels be used for sand barrels and that we start with 10 instead of 15. Sue will check with PW. Chad will contact Scout groups. Karen is working on the Golden Shovel, definite decisions were not made but inviting businesses to participate from the Rotary to Thomas Knight Park as a start was discussed along with having a small sign for participants, publicity and an award.
